Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What if I have my own car and drive myself?

A: If you live in one of the identified Oklahoma counties and receive WIC, you can seek gas reimbursement.

Q: What if my friend or family member drives me to the grocery store or WIC appointment?

A: If you live in one of the identified Oklahoma counties and receive WIC, you can seek gas reimbursement.

Q: What if my nearest grocery store doesn't have as wide a selection as the next closest grocery store?

A: Talk to Christi or Chanler, our transportation helpers. We understand the need to go to a store with a wider variety of food options.

Q: What if I don't have access to a vehicle at all?

A: Christi or Chanler will help set you up with ride assistance that is available in your area.

Q: Is this an easy process?

A: Fill out the form on the OKWIC.org website. Once you are contacted by Christi or Chanler, the process is quick and easy.

Q: How long does this project last?

A: This project is funded through September 30, 2026

Q: What is the purpose of this project?

A: This is a grant-funded project focusing on increasing WIC enrollment and benefits redemption. Transportation is a known barrier in Oklahoma. This project is aiming to help alleviate that barrier.
